

# *Allure Permanent Cosmetics*

## **PRE-PROCEDURE INFORMATION**

All permanent cosmetic procedures are multi-session processes. You are required to return for at least one follow-up visit before it can be determined that your work is complete. Follow-up visits are scheduled at 4-6 week intervals.

Be prepared for the color intensity of your procedure to be significantly sharper, brighter, or darker than what is expected for the final outcome. It will take time for this transition, based on how quickly the outer layer of your skin exfoliates.

While these injected tones may initially simulate the exact color and tone desired, it will not always remain a perfect match. Injected tones are constant, while your own skin tones will vary depending on exposure to cold, heat, sun, and circulatory changes.

1. Since delicate skin or sensitive areas may swell slightly or redden, some clients feel it best not to make social plans for a day or two following any procedure.
2. Wear your normal makeup for your appointment and bring in any lip or brow pencils to the office on the day of your procedures.
3. For clients that are having lip procedures done:
  - a. If you have a history of cold sores / fever blisters (herpes simplex), you will be required to contact your physician to obtain proper prescription medication to prevent such outbreaks. Usually Aciclovir is prescribed. Begin taking the medication two days prior to your appointment. Please contact our office for more information.
  - b. We use a very good topical to help deaden the lips for the lipliner / full lip procedure. However, if you have a low pain tolerance you might want to get a lip block (injections to totally numb the lips) from your dentist.
4. A patch test is offered on request.
